I am currently offering a Warhol canvas of Jack Nicklaus signed by Nicklaus.

I think it is a very special painting because it is NOT iconic for the artist so not run of the mill and common, and at the same time the subject matter is very surely iconic – Nicklaus clearly an American icon whose stature will only increase over time. The combination of Warhol, unique, authenticated, American icon is a great find. This little gem of a painting is museum quality and would be perfect for the home or office of a passionate golfer.

Painting is framed. It is signed by Nicklaus (photos provided on request). It is not signed by Warhol (not unusual), it is stamped by the Warhol Estate for authentication and has an estate authentication number noted on the back of the canvas which means it is registered with the estate and certified as authentic by the stamp.

All things Warhol are heading north at a stampede in terms of value, paintings first. Authenticated paintings are now rarer than rare as the Estate no longer authenticates, so anyone without the stamp and number are holding an asset that is diminished in value. This is a specialty painting for sure, but that makes it incredibly valuable to the right person.

And in terms of golf, Jack Nicklaus stands at the top of the field both in terms of accomplishment, but also reputation and class. Just as all things Palmer are now increasing in value, when Jack's time comes, this painting is going to be much more highly valued. A rare gem, fully certified, easy to look at, at a price that will eventually seem like a theft.
